AFFIDAVIT OF PAUL A. DUFFY

I, Paul A. Duffy, being first duly sworn on oath, under penalties as provided by law pursuant to Section 1-109 of the Illinois Code of Civil Procedure, certify that the statements set forth herein are true and correct and that, if called upon to testify in the above-captioned case, I could competently testify to the following statements based upon my personal knowledge:

1. I am 53 years old, employed and reside in Chicago, Illinois, and have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this affidavit and will testify to the same if called upon.

2. I am an attorney at the Duffy Law Group, located in Chicago, IL 60602. I am licensed in good standing to practice law in Illinois and have been since 1992. I am also licensed in good standing to practice law in Massachusetts, California and several United States Districts Courts.

3. I have carefully reviewed and am familiar with the Affidavit of Special Process Server, Jerry F. Willson, filed by Plaintiff, Freeborn & Peters LLP ("Freeborn"), which purports that on January 23, 2013, I was served with a Summons and Verified Complaint in this matter.

4. I have also carefully reviewed and am familiar with Freeborn's Complaint, which is not Verified despite the attestation of Jerry F. Willson claiming that he served me with a Summons and Verified Complaint.



5. On January 23, 2013, I was not served with a *Summons, Alias Summons or any Complaint* outside of the Daley Center. In fact, on the morning of January 23, 2013, I appeared for 3 case management conference hearings before Judge Gettleman, Judge Kendall and Judge Shadur in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Illinois located at 219 S. Dearborn Street, Chicago, Illinois.

6. As of today's date, March 18, 2013, I have not been personally served with a *Summons, Alias Summons or any Complaint* on this matter.

7. From March 2004 through March 2011, I was employed by Freeborn. As required of its employees, throughout the time of my employment, I informed and updated Freeborn of my residence address.

8. In December 2007, I moved to my current residence in Chicago, Illinois. At that time, I informed Freeborn of my change in address.

9. From December 2007 through the time when I resigned from Freeborn on March 13, 2011, Freeborn had full knowledge of and mailed various correspondences to my current residence. In fact, on or about March 4, 2013, I received correspondence forwarded to me from Freeborn through the United States Mail.


10. As of today's date, March 18, 2013, no one residing in my household has been served with a *Summons, Alias Summons or any Complaint* on this matter.

11. In March 2011, immediately after resigning from Freeborn, I opened the Duffy Law Group, 2 North LaSalle Street, 13th Floor, Chicago, IL 60602. This address is listed on the Illinois Attorney Registration and Disciplinary Commission's web site.

13. I am also the Registered Agent of my Co-Defendant in this matter, SafeWorks Illinois Occupational Health Services, Ltd. ("SafeWorks"). The Illinois Secretary of State web site address for Illinois corporations, ilsos.gov, also lists my office address as SafeWorks' Registered Agent at 2 North LaSalle Street, 13th Floor, Chicago, IL 60602.

14. On or about March 6, 2013, I was served with a subpoena *duces tecum* by Freeborn in the matter of *Freeborn & Peters LLP v. Richmond Chemical Corporation*, Circuit Court of Cook County Case Number 2011 L 008730.
